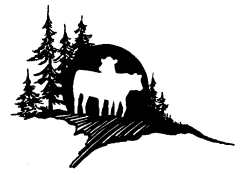

Rules and Regulations

1. Entry closing date is June 7, 2010. Entries maybe mailed, faxed or emailed. Late registrations will be accepted until 9:00 am June 12, 2010 with an additional \$10/ entry fee. Entries received after June 7 will be considered late entries.
2. All exhibitors are responsible for proper care, presentation and cleanup of their exhibits.
3. If there are insufficient entries, the Livestock Committee reserves the right to cancel the classes. Class splits will not exceed more than 12 entries
4. Any situation that is not covered by the rules will be subject to the committee's decision
5. Cross entries for the junior show will be accepted. Entry fees are applicable. All entries in the Open breeding classes must be purebred.
6. All livestock must be equipped with a neck rope and halter.
7. All animals must be stalled by 9:00 am of Saturday June 12, 2010 and cannot be removed until half an hour after completion of the show. Cattle may be stalled on Friday June 11, 2009 6:00 - 9:00 pm. Security will be provided.
8. All animals are to be exhibited at the owner's risk.
9. Livestock, which has been identified to the committee as being surgically altered or unethically fitted for cosmetic reasons, will be disqualified for the show and prize money and entry fees will be revoked. The committee's decision will be final with no recourse or appeal.
10. The exhibitor or the exhibitor's family must own all the animals.
11. All exhibitors must be nine years of age or older on show day
12. Blocking chutes entering the show barn must be clean.
13. NO Ringworm Please.
14. All exhibitors are encouraged to display a farm sign at their stall.
15. All animals in the Open show must be purebred except for the jackpot heifer and steer classes.
16. Steers will be divided into classes according to weight. Steers must be weighed prior to 11:00 AM

Rules and Regulations for the Purebred and Commercial Pen Heifer Show
--

1. The pen heifer show is designated to promote the purebred and commercial cattle industries. Therefore only recognized purebred breeders are eligible to enter the purebred pen classes and only recognized commercial breeders are eligible to enter the commercial pen classes.
2. Pens consist of three heifers which must be born in 2009
3. Heifers must be home raised (raised by the person or farm exhibiting them)
4. The pens of heifers CANNOT be shown at halter in any class of the open show.
5. Heifers must be manageable (halter breaking not necessary)
6. No washing or clipping allowed – brushing and combing only.
7. No use of adhesive or foams.
8. Any situation not covered by the above regulations will be subject to the show committee's decision.
9. Entries must be in pens by 9:00 AM on show day.
10. Cattle will be release 30 minutes after the completion of the open show.
11. Contributors are encouraged to display their farm name on their pen **ONLY AFTER** the judging has been completed.
